Solomon Islands National Youth Worker Awards



The Solomon Islands National Youth Workers Award seeks to promote active citizenship by honoring and profiling outstanding youth workers (35 years and above), by recognizing their enduring positive impact on young people and local communities.

All nominations to reach the Ministry of Women, Youth Children & Family Affairs by or not later than 30th May 2019, as late nomination may not be considered.

The winners for both awards will be officially announced through the Media. The recipients of the awards will then be honored at an awards ceremony. Our media partners will also be keen to profile the recipients and promote their works in the community.

AWARD CATEGORIES

A Youth Worker will be recognized for excellence in each of the following categories:

- Sport
- Music
- Art and Culture
- Community / Church Work and Leadership
- Science and Innovation
- Environment
- Business
- Differently Abled
- Life Rehabilitation – award to recognize a dedicated youth worker who has made a significant improvement in the life of a young person under difficult circumstances and is now making a positive contribution to society

ELIGIBILITY

Nominees must be:

- 35 years old and above
- A citizen of Solomon Islands;
- Nominated by someone else;
- An individual; and
- Not employed by the Ministry of Women, Youth, Children and Family Affairs (MWYCFA) at the time of nomination.

Anyone wishing to nominate a young person for an award must complete the attached nomination form and return it to the Ministry of Women, Youth and Children Affairs (MWYCFA) via:

The nominator *must not* be a close relative of the nominee
